League of Women Voters Hosts Candidate Forum for Bandera City Council

BANDERA—The League of Women Voters of the Hill Country is conducting a Candidate Forum on Tuesday, October 23 from 6:30pm to 8:00pm at Bandera Electric Coop. The two candidates for Mayor of the City of Bandera and the four candidates for the two places on the Bandera City Council have been invited to participate. Candidate forums conducted by the League of Women Voters of the Hill Country are free and open to the public with a focus on audience questions for the candidates.

The ballot for the City of Bandera lists two candidates for Mayor of Bandera: Suzanne Schauman and Cindy Lou Coffey. The position of Mayor is a two-year term. The City Council has two places to fill with four candidates listed on the ballot: Brice Cavanaugh, Glenn Clark, Tomi Kunz, and Gregory A. Gibson. These two positions on the city council are for two-year terms.

The League of Women Voters - Hill Country conducts a candidate forum with League members present who are skilled in organizing candidate forums for elections. A League member moderates the forum with each candidate making an opening statement and a closing statement. Members of the audience attending a candidate forum may submit a question by writing the question on a card provided by the League. Each question is screened by two members of the League and given to the moderator. Each candidate answers the question with a League member serving as a timekeeper for the response time.
